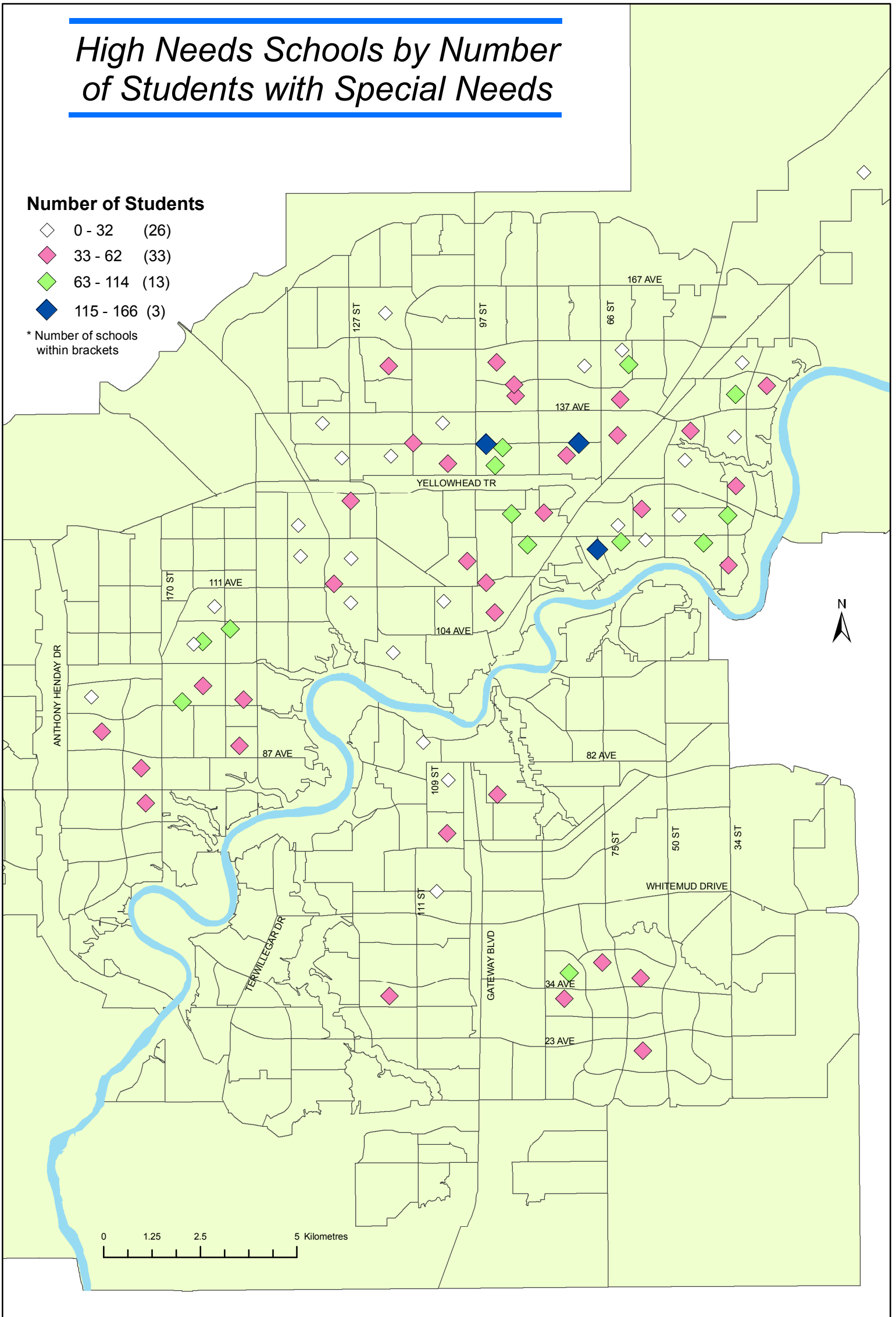


# High Needs Schools by Number of Students with Special Needs

Data Sources: (1) High Needs School designation: "Amount allocated to reflect the characteristics of a school's student community based on enrolment, mobility, and incidence of low family income. Calculated on the basis of a ranking factor and normalized enrolment. The ranking factor is based on mobility (transfers in and out in the previous year) and the incidence of low family income according to the latest Statistics Canada information."  
 (2) Students with Special Education Needs: Students are identified as having special education needs based on individual behavioural, communicational, intellectual, learning, social/emotional and/or physical/medical characteristics. Special education needs vary greatly from one individual to another and may be mild, moderate or severe in nature."
