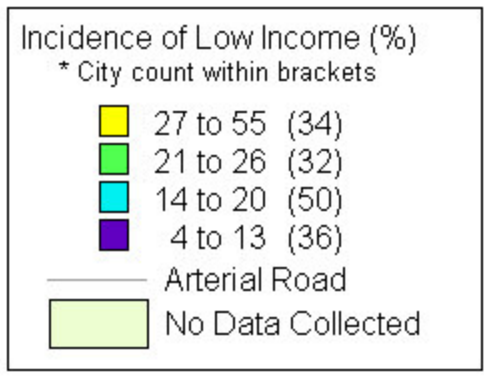


Incidence of Low Income within North Central
