- Feb, 08: demographic maps presented with latest 2006 Federal Census.
- Feb, 08: initial meeting created logic model and selected demographics to map.
- Feb, 08: boundary determined by group.
- Sept, 08: gathering, identifying and mapping resources.
- Dec, 08: modifying resources that are being mapped with Committee.
- Jan, 09: Term of reference created.

Community Profile:

- Oct, 08: decided on a list of resource categories group wish to map.
- Jan, 09: Maps of other agency presented (EPSB, EPL and Health).
- Feb, 09: demographic map portfolio done (2006 Federal Census).
- Apr, 09: resource map portfolio done.

Community Engagement:

- Apr, 08: Named priorities: seniors and children and families.

Action:

- Feb, 09: Space inventory created.
- Mar, 09: Practicum student at Whitemud Crossing Library created Wiki – online web communication tool for South West Community Mapping members.
- Jun, 09: Community Outreach Event held.
- October, 2009: Creation of 2 sub-committees/working groups
 - Enhancing Support Services to Families and
 - Enhancing Support Services to Newcomers
